Under this joint privacy notice (hereinafter the “Notice”), we inform you how we process your personal data on our EEX Group Digital Conference 2021 (hereinafter also “Event”). Your personal data means any information relating to you (hereinafter the “Personal Data”), such as name or contact details.

We pay special attention on the processing of Personal Data in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation EU 2016/679 (“GDPR”) and applicable national data protection laws.

2 Purpose, Categories of Personal Data, Legal Basis and Retention

2.1 Categories of your Personal Data, purposes, legal basis of Our processing

2.1.1 Event Registration Data

When you register for the event We may obtain your name, contact details, email address, position, and company. Which data is collected depends on the individual entry fields of the specific event registration. Mandatory information fields will be marked accordingly. All other information shall be voluntary. We may share your registration data (name, contact details, including email address, position and company) with bodies involved in the organization of the Event for the purpose of access control to the Event. To help structure the discussion and execution of the Event, we may share your registration data (name, position, company, and country) with the moderator, speakers, and panelists prior to the Event. These bodies will use your registration data only for the purposes mentioned above and are obliged to delete the data after the Event. The legal basis is Art. 6 para. 1 lit. (b) of the GDPR, permitting the processing of Personal Data for the purposes of the performance of a contract.

2.1.2 Event Participation Data

As this is a closed conference you need to log-in to the Event with your email address and name. We use this information to contact you after the Event and to provide you with follow-up information for this Event. We will not share this Personal Data with other participants.

We will automatically log information about the browser that is used to access our event platform, such as your IP address, and we may also collect device-specific information, such as your hardware model and operating system.

This information is required to correctly deliver the content of Our website, ensure the permanent functionality of Our information technology systems and the technology of Our website, and provide law enforcement authorities with the information necessary for criminal prosecution in the event of a cyber-attack. These anonymously collected data and information are therefore evaluated statistically and additionally evaluated with the aim of increasing data protection and data security. The anonymous data of the server log files are stored separately from all Personal Data provided by a person concerned.

2.1.3 Communication Data on the Event platform

We are offering you voting and comment functions on Our event platform. By default, you can use them without reference to your name and person. Votes submitted during surveys are aggregated, and only the aggregate voting results are processed further. You can submit comments and questions with or without specifying your name. If questions and comments are assigned to your person and processed together with your name, We will inform you of this in the relevant function. This is done to reply to questions/comments after the Event. The legal basis is Art. 6 para. 1 lit. (f) of the GDPR, permitting the processing of Personal Data for the purposes of Our legitimate interests in processing your voting to an aggregated voting result and to answer your request in a comment.

2.1.4 Speaker Data

We process your name, position, contact details and company when you are a speaker at the Event. Speaker Data will be visible for participants of the event website. The legal basis is Art. 6 para. 1 lit. (a) of the GDPR, permitting the processing of Personal Data for the purposes that you have consented.

2.1.5 Video recordings

On live stream sessions, only speakers are recorded. We also offer recorded Teams sessions, which are clearly marked as recorded sessions. By joining these sessions, you consent that your attendance in this meeting will be recorded as well. You can choose to attend a meeting without reference to your name and person as a guest. All recordings of presentations held will be made available on Our event website after the Event. The legal basis is Art. 6 para. 1 lit. (a) of the GDPR, permitting the processing of Personal Data for the purposes that you have consented.

2.2 Do you have to provide your Personal Data to us?

The provision of your Personal Data is necessary to register as an event participant and to use the event platform as a part of a closed user group. This means that you are obliged to provide your Personal Data to Us as part of the event registration process and during the event participation. Personal Data you provide on the event platform remain under your control, as you can always correct or delete this data. The consequences if you do not provide your Personal Data to Us are that you will not be able to participate at the Event.

2.3 Do we make automated decisions on you?

We do not make any automated decisions solely on automatic processing, including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affects you.

2.5 Retention periods

Personal data collected for the event registration will be deleted directly after the Event.

Available recordings of event presentations will be deleted one year after the end of this Event.

Data collected during your event participation will be stored as long as it is necessary in accordance with the legal retention periods, as We are obliged to retain your Personal Data due to tax and commercial duties of storage and documentation, these deadlines are decisive.

3 Transfer of Personal Data to Third Parties

We will not transfer your Personal Data to third parties except such transfer is permitted by law or you have explicitly consented to the transfer.

To make certain services available to you, We may need to share your Personal Data with some of our service partners. These include our registration and event platform provider.

Personal Data published by you in Our event platform may be accessible to other registered users of the event platform.

Otherwise, your Personal Data will be stored exclusively in Our database and on Our servers, or on those of Our commissioned data processing providers. Our commissioned data processing providers process personal data exclusively within the European Union or an adequate data protection level will be provided using appropriate safeguards in accordance with Article 44 et seq. of the GDPR.

4 Your Rights

Under applicable data protection laws, you have rights

- of access to, rectification of, and/or erasure of your Personal Data;
- to restrict or object to its processing;
- to the extent Our processing of your Personal Data is based on your consent, you also have the right to withdraw your consent, without affecting the lawfulness of Our processing based on your consent before its withdrawal.
